Click on the "Sign In" button on that page and you will be requested to enter your email address, which will be used to complete the access to the store and to send you a receipt when your purchase is completed. Follow the directions and you will be offered Adult and Child tickets. You will select the number of each type of ticket that you wish. At checkout you will need to supply your credit card information, your name, and your address. Both you and the church will receive a copy of the receipt for your purchase.
